Rules and Regulations:

- 1. The show is open to all exhibitors and there is no limit on the number of animals that can be entered in a class by an exhibitor. All entries MUST be checked in by 4:30 pm on Friday, September 1, 2023.
- 2. Bedding is NOT provided. You must bring your own.
- 3. ENTRY FEE IS \$5.00 PER HEAD, LATE ENTRIES ARE \$7.00 PER HEAD.
- 4. ENTRY FORMS ARE DUE AUGUST 26, 2023
- 5. SEND ENTRY FORMS TO: Pam Hethcote, 7612 Possum Hollow Road, Lyles, Tennessee 37098. Make checks payable to Dickson County Fair.
- 6. All Tennessee Health rules shall be observed. Refer to the Tennessee Dept. of Agriculture Health Requirements and exhibitor must have in his or possession a certificate or statement from a licensed veterinarian dated within 90 days (TN residents) or 30 days for out of sate exhibitors., declaring the herd to be disease free and healthy. Anyone failing to present the required statement or certificate will NOT be allowed to show. Anyone presenting for exhibition an unhealthy animal, an animal that would pose risk to the general public, or animals not representing for Dickson County Fair in a poitive way will risk having the entire herd refused or specific animals quarantined at the individual or collective discretion on the Dept. Head, the LivestockSuperintendent, or Official State Veterinarian. All decisions of Dept. Head,

- Livestock Superintendent, or Official State Veterinarian are FINAL. NO entry fees will be refunded. Any questions regarding infectious or contagious disease of a herd shall be brought to the attention of the Superintendents.
- 7. Goats under 6 onth of age may be shown with stamped duplicate application for registration. Original registrations certificates are required for all goats 6 months and older.
- 8. No horned animals.
- 9. No bucks.
- 10. No dogs in barn area.
- 11. Disqualification will result if (1) goat shows pronounced defect or abnormality, (2) illegible tattoos or tattoos inconsistant with registration certificates, (3) or any doe over 24 months of age that has not kidded and cannot prove a current pregancy at time of show.
- 12. No open containers of milk allowed. Milk must be disposed of in approved receptacles.
- 13. There will be no pre-show milk out.
