SENIOR: 4-H Club members in grades 9, 10, 11, or 12 on January 1 of the current year.

4. All non-perishable items (everything except plants/flowers and

baking must be registered on TUESDAY, AUGUST 29 FROM 4:00 - 7:00 pm. Pre-registration is encouraged. Baked Goods and Plants/ Flowers must be registered between 4:00 - 6:00 pm on Thursday, August 31. Please follow the directions on the pre-registration form in this catalog to avoid delays during check-in at the fair. 5. A collection of flowers must include three(3) of the same variety.

- 6. All canned goods must be in standard, clear glass jars with two piece tops and should be labeled with the name of the product and date. Judges are allowed to open any jar of food on exhibit.
- 7. All art and photography entries must be ready to hang.
- 8. Prizes will awarded based on the decision of the judge(s). Judge(s) will not be required to award prizes unless the quality of the entry is deserving of recognition.

- 9. All articles are exhibited at the owner's risk, but all reasonable precautions will be taken for protection of the itmes.
- 10. Label items by class and lot number before bringing to the fair. Please follow the directions on the pre-registration form in this catalog toavoid delays during check-in at the fair.
- 11. All exhibits MUST be collected by the owners between 4:00 - 6:00 pm on Tuesday, September 5 after the fair. MANAGEMENT IS NOT RESPONSIBLE AFTER THIS TIME.
