RULES AND REGULATIONS:

State Law requires that ALL poultry brought on fairgrounds property must have tested negative for pullorum within 90 days prior to the beginning of the fair or be N.P.I.P. certified. NO EXCEPTIONS. A representative from the Dept. of Agriculture will be present to conduct testing.

The Fair Show is open to all residents of Dickson and surrounding counties and members of the Volunteer State Poultry Club (V.S.P.C.). The Poultry Show will be managed and sponsored in part by the Volunteer State Poultry Club.

Entry Fee - \$2.00 per bird. Checks are apyable to the **Volunteer State Poultry Club (V.S.P.C.) ENTRY DEADLINE IS AUGUST 25, 2023. NO EXCEPTIONS.** No late entries will be permitted. Phone entries will be allowed only if health certificate has been received. There will an entry limit of 300 birds. (First come, first serve).

Birds will be received on **Wednesday, August 30, 2023 from 3:00 pm - 7:00 pm.** All birds must be couped by 5:00 pm Monday. all birds shall be of an age to be full feathered (at least three months). Any birds showing symptoms of illness or parasites will be refused.

Judging will done during the day during the fair. The judge's decision is final.

All birds will be fed and watered daily, with every precaution taken. However, the Volunteer State Poultry Club will not be responsible for loss or accident.

Birds will be relased on Monday, September 4, 2023 after 3:00 p.m. Please see show officials for assistance. V.S.P. C. nor the Dickson Fair Board will be responsible for any birds left past closing of the fair. **No birds will be relased early or prize money will be forfeited.**

Super Grand Champion will be awared from both Junior and Open Show.

Passes are only given to workers, not exhibitors.

Juniors must coop their own birds and must be at least 6 years old and cannot have reached their 17th birthday.

Turkeys and Guineas will be judged as described in the American Poultry Association (APA) Standard of Perfection.

There will be an Ugly Chicken and a Pretty Chicken Contest which will be judged by popular vote. Each bird will have amoney jar. Over the course of the fair, people can vote by .

putting money in the jar. On Saturday at noon, they money will be counted and the chicken with the most money will be awarded the title of ugliest chicken.

Entries are limited to the 5, the first 5 entries we receive. Winners in each category will receive an award from the Volunteer State oultry Club.

Premiums:

The following premiums will be paid in all varieties of cocks, hens, pullets and cockerels when ehere are three or more birds showing in the four categories.
